A PERPETUAL ROSARY TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

The gift of a grace from Mother Mary

This retreat, a focus of the resurrection flame, is under the charge of Jesus and Mother Mary.

On August 22, 1992, in a dictation given at the conclusion of the Saturday evening service, *Mother Mary asked for a perpetual prayer vigil of the rosary.*

She promised to return in seven days to accord us a “special grace or dispensation.” Mary said: “I ask you to think about this for seven days and then come to a conclusion as to what special grace you might ask of me.”

She requested that for fourteen days we alternate giving the long scriptural rosary on one day and the Surrender Rosary on the next. She said this would assist us to ask for a grace that would enable us “to become who we are, to fulfill our mission and to serve others.” (vol. 35 no. 34)

On August 29, at the Saint Germain Service, the congregation wrote letters to Mother Mary, stating the grace they would like to receive. Saint Germain tells us that Mother Mary has molded the gift to our deepest need and to the equation of the hour of our lifestream. Forget not the inner resolution by the violet flame and by the joy of the heart. Forget not, beloved ones, the altar of God.

Decree 56.03: Fatima Prayers

1. Prayer for Pardon from the Angel of Peace

(This prayer was given to the three children at Fátima in 1916 by the Angel of Peace on his first appearance to them. He knelt and bowed down until his forehead touched the ground and made the children repeat the prayer with him. Afterwards he instructed them, "Pray thus. The hearts of Jesus and Mary are attentive to the voice of your supplications.")

O my God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love thee. I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love thee. (1x)

2. Prayer for Eucharistic Reparation from the Angel of Peace

(During his third and last visit to the children, the Angel of Peace knelt beside them and made them repeat this prayer three times. He served them Holy Communion, then bowed low and touched his head to the ground, repeating the prayer again with them three times.)

Most Holy Trinity—Father, Son and Holy Spirit— I adore thee profoundly. I offer thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifferences whereby he is offended. And through the infinite merits of his most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of thee the conversion of poor sinners. (1x)

3. Prayer for Making Sacrifices from Mother Mary

(Mother Mary gave this prayer to the three children at Fátima when she appeared to them on July 13, 1917. She told them to “make sacrifices for sinners and say [this prayer] often, especially while making a sacrifice.”)

O Jesus, this is for the love of thee, for the conversion of sinners and in reparation for sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. (1x)

4. Prayer for Saving Souls from Hell from Mother Mary

(During her Fátima appearances, Mother Mary urged the daily recitation of the Rosary. On July 13, 1917, the Blessed Mother showed the three children at Fátima a terrifying vision of hell, where she told them “the souls of poor sinners go.” She instructed the children to say the following prayer at the end of each decade of the Rosary.)

O my Jesus, forgive us, save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need. (1x)

In the name of the Father, and the Mother, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
