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## The Compassionate Saviouress

Kuan Yin is the compassionate Saviouress of the East. Throughout the Orient altars dedicated to this Mother of Mercy can be found in temples, homes and wayside grottoes, and prayers to her Presence and her Flame are incessantly on the lips of devotees as they seek her guidance and succor in every area of life.

Still very much a part of Eastern culture, Kuan Yin has awakened interest in her path and teaching among a growing number of Western devotees who recognize the powerful presence of "the Goddess of Mercy," along with that of the Virgin Mary, as an illuminator and intercessor of the seventh age of Aquarius.

In this hour of the dark cycle of the Kali Yuga when all upon earth are experiencing the accelerated return of personal and planetary karma, Kuan Yin steps to the fore with Portia, the Goddess of Justice, and other members of the Karmic Board to assist Saint Germain, the hierarch of Aquarius, to rescue a people and a planet and bring in a golden age of freedom, peace, and enlightenment.

As a representative of the Divine Mother and the Divine Helper who has promised to be at our side when we summon her through the science of mantra, Kuan Yin offers us an unprecedented opportunity through her "crystal rosary" to call forth miracles of Mercy's flame for the resolution and healing of every condition or crisis afflicting ourselves, our children, our loved ones, our communities and nations.

In a dictation delivered through me on May 8, 1988, Kuan Yin said, "Try me, beloved. For I come in the midst of the weariness of the saints. I come in the very day and hour when some are overcome by the weight of world karma. . . . I come as a bodhisattva of mercy out of mercy for beloved Saint Germain," who has given his all to save the peoples and nations of the earth.

Kuan Yin came in support of Saint Germain to proclaim the sign and signet of the Aquarian age—the violet transmuting flame of the seventh ray, the sacred fire of the Holy Spirit that is the master's dispensation to the lightbearers. "Let violet flame increase!" she said. "By violet flame and violet flame mantra and by my ancient mantras you recite, I do release to the earth crystal spheres of my rosary, crystal spheres of the yin and the yang, the

Alpha and the Omega of the violet flame and the seventh age. I have for so long carried vials of mercy, being burdened as a woman with child to deliver [them] unto this age, but I must needs find vessels into which I might pour the mercy elixir....

“Call to me and discover how one word and prayer and command to me as you move from one place to the next shall bring to you, as though miraculously, the turning around of worlds....

“I embrace the totality of the Motherhood of God, and I focus it out of the great crystal, specifically for the seventh ray and age, specifically for the awakening and the victory of souls by right choice, right action, right attunement with God. I am so determined that this seventh age shall be a golden age, beloved, that I am everywhere in the consciousness of God where you are. Let miracles of my causal body flow! Let miracles of Kuan Yin flow! Let miracles of the great Buddha flow!”

The long history of devotion to Kuan Yin provides insight into the character and example of this lightbearer who has not only laid down her life for her friends but taken it again and again as intercessor and burdenbearer. For centuries, Kuan Yin has epitomized the great ideal of *Mahāyāna* Buddhism in her role as *bodhisattva* (Chinese *p'u-sa*)—literally “a being of bodhi, or enlightenment,” who is destined to become a Buddha but has forgone the bliss of nirvana with a vow to save all children of God.

The name Kuan Shih Yin, as she is often called, means literally “the one who regards, looks on, or hears the sounds of the world.” According to legend, Kuan Yin was about to enter heaven but paused on the threshold as the cries of the world reached her ears.

There is still much scholarly debate regarding the origin of devotion to the female bodhisattva Kuan Yin. Kuan Yin is considered to be the feminine form of *Avalokiteśvara* (Sanskrit), the bodhisattva of compassion of Indian Buddhism whose worship was introduced into China in the third century.

Scholars believe that the Buddhist monk and translator Kumārajīva was the first to refer to the female form of Kuan Yin in his Chinese translation of the *Lotus Sutra* in A.D. 406. Of the thirty-three appearances of the bodhisattva referred to in his translation, seven are female. (Devoted Chinese and Japanese Buddhists have since come to associate the number thirty-three with Kuan Yin.)

Although Kuan Yin was still being portrayed as a male as late as the tenth century, with the introduction of Tantric Buddhism into China in the eighth century during the T'ang dynasty, the image of the celestial bodhisattva as a beautiful white-robed goddess was predominant and the devotional cult surrounding her became increasingly popular. By the ninth century there was a statue of Kuan Yin in every Buddhist monastery in China.

Despite the controversy over the origins of Kuan Yin as a feminine being, the depiction of a bodhisattva as both 'god' and 'goddess' is not inconsistent with Buddhist doctrine. The scriptures explain that a bodhisattva has the power to embody in any form—male, female, child, even animal—depending on the type of being he is seeking to save. As the Lotus Sutra relates, the bodhisattva Kuan Shih Yin, "by resort to a variety of shapes, travels in the world, conveying the beings to salvation."<sup>\*</sup>

The twelfth-century legend of the Buddhist saint Miao Shan, the Chinese princess who lived in about 700 B.C. and is widely believed to have been Kuan Yin, reinforced the image of the bodhisattva as a female. During the twelfth century Buddhist monks settled on P'u-t'o Shan—the sacred island-mountain in the Chusan Archipelago off the coast of Chekiang where Miao Shan is said to have lived for nine years, healing and saving sailors from shipwreck—and devotion to Kuan Yin spread throughout northern China.

This picturesque island became the chief center of worship of the compassionate Saviouress; crowds of pilgrims would journey from the remotest places in China and even from Manchuria, Mongolia and Tibet to attend stately services there. At one time there were more than a hundred temples on the island and over one thousand monks. The lore surrounding P'u-t'o island recounts numerous appearances and miracles performed by Kuan Yin, who, it is believed, reveals herself to the faithful in a certain cave on the island.

In the Pure Land sect of Buddhism, Kuan Yin forms part of a ruling triad that is often depicted in temples and is a popular theme in Buddhist art. In the center is the Buddha of Boundless Light, Amitābha (Chinese, A-mi-t'o Fo; Japanese, Amida). To his right is the bodhisattva of strength or power, Mahāsthāmapraptā, and to

his left is Kuan Yin, personifying his endless mercy.

In Buddhist theology Kuan Yin is sometimes depicted as the captain of the “Bark of Salvation,” guiding souls to Amitābha’s Western Paradise, or Pure Land—the land of bliss where souls may be reborn to receive continued instruction toward the goal of enlightenment and perfection. The journey to Pure Land is frequently represented in woodcuts showing boats full of Amitābha’s followers under Kuan Yin’s captainship.

Amitābha, a beloved figure in the eyes of Buddhists desiring to be reborn in his Western Paradise and to obtain freedom from the wheel of rebirth, is said to be, in a mystical or spiritual sense, the father of Kuan Yin. Legends of the Mahāyāna School recount that Avalokiteśvara was ‘born’ from a ray of white light which Amitābha emitted from his right eye as he was lost in ecstasy.

Thus Avalokiteśvara, or Kuan Yin, is regarded as the “reflex” of Amitābha—a further emanation or embodiment of *maha karuna* (great compassion), the quality which Amitābha himself embodies in the highest sense. Many figures of Kuan Yin can be identified by the presence of a small image of Amitābha in her crown. It is believed that as the merciful redemptress Kuan Yin expresses Amitābha’s compassion in a more direct and personal way and prayers to her are answered more quickly.

The iconography of Kuan Yin depicts her in many forms, each one revealing a unique aspect of her merciful presence. As the sublime Goddess of Mercy whose beauty, grace and compassion have come to represent the ideal of womanhood in the East, she is frequently portrayed as a slender woman in flowing white robes who carries in her left hand a white lotus, symbol of purity. Ornaments may adorn her form, symbolizing her attainment as a bodhisattva, or she may be pictured without them as a sign of her great virtue.

Kuan Yin’s presence is widespread through her images as the “bestower of children” which are found in homes and temples. A great white veil covers her entire form and she may be seated on a lotus. She is often portrayed with a child in her arms, near her feet, or on her knees, or with several children about her. In this role, she is also referred to as the “white-robed honored one.” Sometimes to her right and left are her two attendants, Shan-ts’ai Tung-ts’i, the “young man of excellent capacities,” and Lung-wang Nü,

the “daughter of the Dragon-king.”

Kuan Yin is also known as patron bodhisattva of P'u-t'o Shan, mistress of the Southern Sea and patroness of fishermen. As such she is shown crossing the sea seated or standing on a lotus or with her feet on the head of a dragon.

Like Avalokiteśvara she is also depicted with a thousand arms and varying numbers of eyes, hands and heads, sometimes with an eye in the palm of each hand, and is commonly called “the thousand-arms, thousand-eyes” bodhisattva. In this form she represents the omnipresent mother, looking in all directions simultaneously, sensing the afflictions of humanity and extending her many arms to alleviate them with infinite expressions of her mercy.

Symbols characteristically associated with Kuan Yin are a willow branch, with which she sprinkles the divine nectar of life; a precious vase symbolizing the nectar of compassion and wisdom, the hallmarks of a bodhisattva; a dove, representing fecundity; a book or scroll of prayers which she holds in her hand, representing the dharma (teaching) of the Buddha or the sutra (Buddhist text) which Miao Shan is said to have constantly recited; and a rosary adorning her neck with which she calls upon the Buddhas for succor.

Images of Avalokiteśvara often show him holding a rosary; descriptions of his birth say he was born with a white crystal rosary in his right hand and a white lotus in his left. It is taught that the beads represent all living beings and the turning of the beads symbolizes that Avalokiteśvara is leading them out of their state of misery and repeated rounds of rebirth into nirvana.

Today Kuan Yin is worshiped by Taoists as well as Mahāyāna Buddhists—especially in Taiwan, Japan, Korea and once again in her homeland of China, where the practice of Buddhism had been suppressed by the communists during the Cultural Revolution (1966–69). She is the protectress of women, sailors, merchants, craftsmen, and those under criminal prosecution, and is invoked particularly by those desiring progeny. Beloved as a mother figure and divine mediatrix who is very close to the daily affairs of her devotees, Kuan Yin's role as Buddhist Madonna has been compared to that of Mary the mother of Jesus in the West.

There is an implicit trust in Kuan Yin's saving grace and healing powers. Many believe that even the simple recitation of her

name will bring her instantly to the scene. One of the most famous texts associated with the bodhisattva, the ancient Lotus Sutra whose twenty-fifth chapter, dedicated to Kuan Yin, is known as the “Kuan Yin sutra,” describes thirteen cases of impending disaster—from shipwreck to fire, imprisonment, robbers, demons, fatal poisons and karmic woes—in which the devotee will be rescued if his thoughts dwell on the power of Kuan Yin. The text is recited many times daily by those who wish to receive the benefits it promises.

Devotees also invoke the bodhisattva’s power and merciful intercession with the mantra OM MANI PADME HUM—“Hail to the jewel in the lotus!” or, as it has also been interpreted, “Hail to Avalokiteśvara, who is the jewel in the heart of the lotus of the devotee’s heart!” Throughout Tibet and Ladakh, Buddhists have inscribed OM MANI PADME HUM on flat prayer stones called “mani-stones” as votive offerings in praise of Avalokiteśvara. Thousands of these stones have been used to build mani-walls that line the roads entering villages and monasteries.

It is believed that Kuan Yin frequently appears in the sky or on the waves to save those who call upon her when in danger. Personal stories can be heard in Taiwan, for instance, from those who report that during World War II when the United States bombed the Japanese-occupied Taiwan, she appeared in the sky as a young maiden, catching the bombs and covering them with her white garments so they would not explode.

Thus altars dedicated to the Goddess of Mercy are found everywhere—shops, restaurants, even taxicab dashboards. In the home she is worshiped with the traditional “pai pai,” a prayer ritual using incense, as well as the use of prayer charts—sheets of paper designed with pictures of Kuan Yin, lotus flowers, or pagodas and outlined with hundreds of little circles. With each set of prayers recited or sutras read in a novena for a relative, friend, or oneself, another circle is filled in. This chart has been described as a “Ship of Salvation” whereby departed souls are saved from the dangers of hell and the faithful safely conveyed to Amitābha’s heaven. In addition to elaborate services with litanies and prayers, devotion to Kuan Yin is expressed in the popular literature of the people in poems and hymns of praise.

Devout followers of Kuan Yin may frequent local temples and

make pilgrimages to larger temples on important occasions or when they are burdened with a special problem. The three yearly festivals held in her honor are on the nineteenth day of the second month (celebrated as her birthday), of the sixth month, and of the ninth month based on the Chinese lunar calendar.

In the tradition of the Great White Brotherhood Kuan Yin is known as the ascended lady master who bears the office and title of "Goddess of Mercy" because she ensouls the God qualities of the law of mercy, compassion and forgiveness. She had numerous embodiments prior to her ascension thousands of years ago and has taken the vow of the bodhisattva to teach the unascended children of God how to balance their karma and fulfill their divine plan by loving service to life and the application of the violet flame through the Science of the Spoken Word.

Kuan Yin preceded the ascended master Saint Germain as chohan (lord) of the seventh ray of freedom, transmutation, mercy and justice, and she is one of eight ascended masters who serve on the Karmic Board, a council of justice that mediates the karma of earth's evolutions—dispensing opportunity, mercy and the true and righteous judgments of the Lord to each lifestream on earth. She is hierarch of the etheric Temple of Mercy over Peking (Beijing), China, where she focuses the light of the Divine Mother on behalf of the children of the ancient land of China, the souls of humanity, and the sons and daughters of God.

Today Kuan Yin is calling those from every field of endeavor and path of devotion to join her in keeping the flame of life on earth through her "crystal rosary." This ritual of prayer and meditation is derived from ancient Chinese mantras, sutras and novenas combined with songs and mantras to the Divine Mother East and West, including the Hail Mary as well as dynamic decrees invoking the violet flame and the protection of the heavenly hosts.

The "Ten Vows of Kuan Yin" are taken from the Great Compassion Heart Dharani Sutra in which the bodhisattva Kuan Yin explains that those who wish to "bring forth a heart of great compassion for all beings . . . should first follow me in making these vows." Sacred names, titles and mantras of Kuan Yin that have been used for centuries to call forth her intercession and inspiration have been arranged according to the fourteen stations of the Aquarian cross.

The Woman and her seed\*—the Divine Mother and her lightbearers on earth—are experiencing these initiations in this transition from the two-thousand-year dispensation of Pisces to Aquarius. Therefore mantras to Kuan Yin are alternated with the Hail Mary to assist the Keepers of the Flame of the Divine Mother on earth in passing their tests.

These mantras are sealed with the words of the Magnificat set to music, the “Ave Maria” with New Age words written for Franz Schubert’s “Ave Maria,” and calls to Archangel Michael and to God as Elohim for world transmutation by the violet flame. The mantras to the “Thirty-Three Manifestations of Avalokiteśvara as Kuan Yin” are taken from a set of thirty-three forms of Kuan Yin venerated in China beginning in about the seventh century.

Kuan Yin’s Crystal Rosary is not only a celebration in praise of the beloved Mediatrix of Mercy and her Flame but also the means whereby Kuan Yin is able to fortify us day by day to face the severe challenges that have been prophesied for our planet in this time.

Serving with Jesus Christ and Lord Gautama, Maitreya, Sanat Kumara and the ascended hosts as a World Mother, Kuan Yin is our friend, mentor and protector who can and does help us as we cooperate with the heavenly hierarchy—the entire Spirit of the Great White Brotherhood—to defeat all that opposes the divine plan and divine identity of every soul of light on earth.

By the intonation of Kuan Yin’s mantras the disciple of the sacred mysteries enters a unique geometry of the sound of the Word of God that leads to the heart of the Divine Mother and the higher levels of his Real Self in order to fulfill the call of the Bodhisattva of Compassion: to literally become the embodiment of the Divine Mother and her universal manchild for the saving of the one and the many.

In a dictation given on April 3, 1988, Kuan Yin explained that “by music and sound you do have the best means for entering higher vibrations and compartments of God.... Every call you make to me, I promise you, shall go in my very heart as momentum for the saving of the pearls of light now lost in the astral sea. For this cause does Mother Mary shed perpetual tears. For this cause do I join the hosts of the Lord, enarmored, beloved, moving with

the archangels and Astrea to go after them. It is my mission of love....

“Those, then, who take my rosary and give it shall increase mercy unto themselves first and foremost, and that mercy descending in your cup... shall fill all of your house until the abundance of your mercy called forth and returned to you may then be extended in wider and wider circles. As we all require mercy and as some will surely be lost without it, I am determined to be the Bodhisattva of Mercy until not another soul requires it, for by my example many shall have become it.”

In a momentous dictation given in San Francisco on February 14, 1988, following my lecture on “The Path of the Divine Mother East and West: Mother Mary and Kuan Yin,” the Goddess of Mercy announced that “this is the hour when you may appeal to the Lords of Karma for a dispensation of mercy’s flame, violet flame when you make the request to use that dispensation specifically for the mitigation, turning back, transmutation of those prophecies” that may come to pass.

“Therefore, all who will join me in the bodhisattva vow for the saving of lightbearers in the earth, to you I say, the extraordinary light of the violet flame is given to those who will direct it and invest it in the saving of that which could be lost without that impetus and in the transmutation of the karma of lightbearers that can be taken in this hour.”

That same day Mother Mary, with whom Kuan Yin serves very closely, said: “I am your Mother initiator with Kuan Yin.... Sound the note—the note of harmony, the note of warning, the note of the teaching, the note of the Guru and the Divine Mother. Let the souls hear this chime and the chime of the ancient bell sounding, then, for the seventh age and ray. Let the violet flame, as ribbons of light, contact all hearts who yearn for Kuan Yin, for Saint Germain, for light eternal.”

Mother Mary once told us that “the blessed Kuan Yin has become known as the Saviouress out of the East performing the selfsame and identical function as my own, yet each of us bringing to this office of Mother our own past attainment and experience which is different by our very service on differing rays.”

In her April 17, 1988, dictation Mother Mary encouraged us

to recite the Hail Mary, which is included on Kuan Yin's Crystal Rosary, "even alternately with the OM MANI PADME HUM\* and Kuan Yin and I will weave a purple and emerald garland, a rope that becomes the lifeline lowered into the astral pits.... With Kuan Yin I come. I come, then, with a thread of my heart going to everyone of this nation who in this or any previous life has spoken my name in devotion and prayer."

Kuan Yin teaches that through each mantra and prayer, song and decree that form the crystal beads of her rosary, the Divine Mother weaves an 'umbilical cord' to souls entangled in the 'bitter sea' of karmic circumstance. As you intone the Divine Word and magnetize the aura of the Compassionate One, you are able to send forth a thousand needlelike rays from your own heart—each one another nuance of compassion—to someone somewhere in need.

Having put on the light and consciousness of Kuan Yin and the ascended masters of the Great White Brotherhood with whom she works, you not only wield a greater capacity and creativity in your chosen service to life but you are also able to transmit to others the energy and vibration of the violet flame and the seventh ray for true spiritual healing and liberation. On the occasion of the recording of these mantras at King Arthur's Court at the Royal Teton Ranch, our spiritual community-in-the-making, Kuan Yin's presence was very tangibly felt and she revealed to us that through the pure energies of our devotions she had been able to save certain souls in America that very afternoon.

Kuan Yin promised us in her May 8, 1988, dictation: "Each time you give any of my mantras, beloved, the pronouncement of my name within the heart and being of an individual does make me ecstatically, instantaneously one with that flesh-and-blood body. Understand that God has given to me this grace for the bodhisattva vow I have taken, for he is the merciful God in whose image I am made. And this merciful God has had mercy for me as I have vowed to stay and stay until eternal life be vouchsafed to all who are of it and worthy of it.

"Therefore, know, beloved, that that mercy does give me these powers. That mercy does give to me, in response to my vow,

wisdom and love and the very ingenuity for action, for preaching the dharma, for reaching anyone everywhere, and you may be the same.

“May you, then, in so lovingly and adoringly giving these mantras, begin to memorize them and... begin to understand how I may come in one of my many bodies to be the fulfillment of a crisis because you as the alchemist have selected the exact vibration for the cure. A cure is needed here and there and everywhere, a cure for every handiwork and handyman.... A cure is needed whatever your role of service.”

Kuan Yin described her rosary as “a crystal bell that sounds and intones itself in many levels of Matter, including the astral plane. That rosary, beloved, enables me to be anywhere and everywhere where that sound does reach. Oh it is a powerful doorway that I may enter as I seek to become physical more each day!

“I ask you to prove me, to make your demands upon me and to command my light and to keep on so doing until you should sense you have reached the limitations of my office. For I tell you, beloved, there is no thing of the will of God that I will not alchemically precipitate—if you are able to bear it, to hold the harmony for it and if you seek the internal integration of the soul in the seventh-ray chakra with the fiery heart of the living Christ bodhisattva.”
