

"Why is Reincarnation Biblical?"

Defenders of the Faith,

Many Christians do not believe reincarnation is in the Bible, which prevents them from being able to accept or appreciate the teachings. So, how do we respond to this worthwhile question when asked by Christians who remain skeptical about the teachings because of this perceived difference?

In Matthew 12, Jesus lectures the scribes and Pharisees and says, "A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things [that is, good works, good karma], and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things [bad works, bad karma]."

The Sermon on the Mount is also a treasure trove of the law of karma. Jesus states the mathematical precision of the law of karma: "For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again..... So, in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets."

But the keystone of Jesus' teaching on reincarnation in the New Testament is our Lord's statement that John the Baptist was Elijah come again.

This Sunday, we will discuss the history of the world's belief in reincarnation and where it appears in the Bible, philosophical writings, literature, and other religious texts, as well as what it means for us, as Chelas on the path.
